

# Alphabet Materials List



- A** – apple stickers, animal stickers or small animals, ant stickers, plastic ants, toy ambulance, use the letter A as an airplane runway for a toy airplane, animal crackers
- B** – blue paper strips/collage items, blue sticker dots, balloon stickers, artificial berries, beads, buttons, dried beans, band-aids, small blocks, balloon painting, counting bears, bows, bubble paint, use a balloon to paint or stamp the letter....
- C** – car stickers or stamps, crayons, cardboard scraps, candy, coins, cookies, small cars, candles, cubes, corn, crayons, print with a small corn on the cob...
- D** – dot markers or dot stickers, dinosaur counters or stickers, dominoes, dice, plastic ducks, small plastic dinosaurs or dragons. dog stickers, dog treats, donut holes, dandelions, daisies...
- E** – smashed egg shells, Easter egg stickers, erasers, small plaster eggs, googly eyes, print with half a plastic Easter egg, Elmo stickers, elephant stickers...
- F** – feathers, dried or silk flowers, fingerprints, fish stickers, flag stickers, small flags, fruit loops, plastic frogs, plastic fish, photos of friends, photos of family members, foam, strips of foil...
- G** – glitter pens, glitter or glitter paper or glitter foam strips/squares, green collage items, goldfish crackers, Easter grass, grass clippings, drips of glue, plastic grapes, pieces of gum...
- H** – smiley face stickers (happy), heart stamps or stickers, hair (use doll hair from the craft store), Monopoly houses, small plastic horses, horse stickers, holes (make holes with a hole punch) ...
- I** – insect counters or stickers, ice cream stickers, ink, plastic ice cubes, ivy, broken ice cream cones, plastic icicle ornaments...
- J** – jingle bells, jellybeans, jewels, jack-o-lantern stickers or erasers...
- K** – keys, key prints, kite stickers, kale, kangaroo stickers/stamps, Hershey's kisses, lip-print kisses...
- L** – letter stickers, legos, lace, ladybug stamps/stickers, plastic lady bugs, leaves (real or silk), lentils, lids, lollipops, plastic lemons, lemon prints...

**M** – dried macaroni, marshmallows, play money, stick-on mustaches, markers, plastic mice, marble painting, m&m's, monkeys (from a barrel full of monkeys game) ...

**N** – strips of newspaper, noodles, nest materials, number stickers, nose pictures, nuts...

**O** – orange paper/collage elements, ovals, owl stickers/stamps, ocean stickers, oatmeal, mini oreos, ocean animals, cherrios...

**P** – popcorn, purple paper or collage elements, puzzle pieces, paper clips, post-it notes, pennies, pom-poms, Pez candies, paw print stickers/stamps, pencil, paint, paper strips, photos of pets, peanuts...

**Q** – squares of patterned fabric to look like a quilt, q-tips, quarters, question mark stamps...

**R** – red paper or collage elements, rainbow stickers, rose petals, rough textures (sand paper), rocks, ribbons, rice, rainbow rice, rubber bands, ribbon strips, toy rings...

**S** – snow (cotton balls, white puff balls, or fake snow used for Christmas village displays), snow flake stickers, white glitter, smiley face stickers, spaghetti noodles, stamps, sand, stars, sequins, strips of string, drinking straws, straw, streamers, sticks, seeds...

**T** – toilet paper, strips of tape, triangles, train stickers/stamps, toothpicks, tissue paper, tickets, turtle stickers, plastic turtles, small toy tractors...

**U** – letter u stamps/stickers, drink umbrellas, arrow stickers or stamps (up) ...

**V** – violet paper or collage elements, artificial violet flowers, vegetable stickers, vegetable pictures from a seed catalog, print with vegetables, Valentine stickers, vines...

**W** – watermelon stickers, wheel prints, plastic worms, wagon wheel pasta, water color...

**X** – letter X stamp, x-ray strips (I found great x-ray printables [HERE](#) at Tried and True. I printed them on some vellum paper that I happened to have on hand and they look amazing), x tile spacers from the home improvement store, number six stamps...

**Y** – yarn, yellow paper or collage elements...

**Z** – zig zags (cut small strips of zig zag paper using pinking scissors) zoo animals, zippers, attach a zipper to a block to make a zipper print or stamp, small zoo animals or zoo animal stickers...
